However, according to RBC's annual homeownership poll, millennials were at the fore of an overall increase in home-buying intentions, with 50 per cent of those aged between 18 and 34 saying they were very or somewhat likely to purchase within the next couple of years.</i> <i>This means that millennials are increasingly looking for more affordable options such as condominiums and townhouses that serve as entry points to homeownership.</i> <i>Given the importance of millennials to the condominium industry, we'll discuss how to recruit younger people to CCI and how to leverage their skills to better reach millennials who will, sooner rather than later, represent a majority of condominium owners.</i>
