Purpose/Mandate:

The Community Committee creates and manages programs ("Activities") that have members of CCI ("Peers") interact with each other directly. Such Activities are to deliver value, while creating a strong bond between Peers:

- (f) Develop Peer to Peer Interaction
 - To create Peer to Peer Activities based on in person interaction
 - To create Peer to Peer Activities based on virtual or technology assisted interaction
- (g) Development of a meaningful educational series to answer needs of condo boards and industry professionals
 - Develop a database of Chapter seminars (seminars/workshops/lunch 'n learns)
 - Make available to all Chapters to facilitate sharing of information on topics and presentations which have been developed
 - Survey Chapter Education Chairs to determine educational needs on a Chapter level and how the committee can assist
 - Provide training and framework for education
 - Create 1 to 2 National Seminars per year to present either in-person or via webinar
- (h) National Newsletter Content
 - Production and distribution of regular national newsletter to Chapters in electronic or hard copy format
 - Encourage submission of Chapter event/recognition photos and articles for National newsletter to highlight Chapter success and member achievements
 - To annually review all communications/newsletter policies and practices
 - To review the newsletters produced by the Chapters
 - Award H. Penman Smith Award to one or more chapters at the annual national awards banquet



2018 Identified Priorities:

These priorities to not constitute part of the Terms of Reference, but outline the current priorities of committee, in conjunction with the purpose/mandate of the committee. These are expected to be reviewed and updated yearly by the National Executive.

- 1. To integrate the CondoStrength program into this committee
- 2. To Develop two national seminars each year (person or web distributed)
- 3. Provide Training and Chapter Frameworks for peer to peer activities and non-accredited activities (luncheons, seminars, speakers, etc.)
- 4. The creation of a National community made up of owners, boards, professionals and business partners where CCI is the facilitator, both IRL and web.
- 5. Redefinition and circulation of the Newsletter of the Year criteria and judging process
- 6. Investigate the use of webinars for outreach to areas without current course availability
